Here are the instructions for this week's Community Project:

Read Mark 11:1-10 (For context, read Mark 11:1-33)

STUDY:

There and then questions:

- 1. What questions arise in your reading?
- 2. What seems to be Mark's main point in this section of Scripture?
- 3. Just about everywhere Jesus traveled was by foot. Why do you think at this point he needed to ride on a colt?
- 4. What does riding a colt say about Jesus' authority? the Lord! Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!

Here and now questions:

- 5. How do we know we recognize the authority of Jesus?
- 6. Can you identify a time when Jesus did not respond the way you wanted?
- 7. How do we respond when God does not fulfill our expectations?

MEDITATION:

Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!

PROJECT:

- 1. Homemade Lava Lamp
 - a. What you need:
 - i. Vegetable oil
 - ii. Water
 - iii. Food Colorina
 - iv. Alka-Seltzer tablets
 - v. Vinegar
 - vi. Baking soda
 - b. If you have Alka-Seltzer tablets
 - i. Pour vegetable oil in container
 - ii. Add water slowly to the vegetable oil
 - iii. Put in a few drops of your choice of food coloring
 - iv. Break up the Alka-Seltzer tablets up and add into the container
 - c. If you don't have Alka-Seltzer tablets
 - i. Pour vegetable oil in container
 - ii. Add vinegar slowly to vegetable oil
 - iii. Put in a few drops of food coloring
 - iv. In a separate container mix 1tsp of baking soda and 1tsp of water
 - v. Add you baking soda water combo to the oil and vinegar

a. During the week be on the look out for animals either in your back yard, on the tv, while your driving in the car take a picture of the animal you find. Be creative! Maybe you want to make it a competition with some friends, determine a point system for animals you find and keep track of your points throughout the week.
